The Data Entry and Explorative Platform (DEEP) is an online platform established by analysts for analysts to strengthen collective sense-making during humanitarian crises. DEEP is set up to compile, store, structure and review qualitative data and information, benefitting the wider humanitarian and development community.

DEEP is governed by a multi-stakeholder consortium that consists of IFRC, UNOCHA, UNHCR, OHCHR, UNICEF, JIPS, Okular-Analytics, iMMAP and IDMC. The DEEP secretariat is established and hosted by Danish Refugee Council. The platform is developed and maintained by the Data Friendly Space - DEEP's principal technology partner.
